You will work closely with the Engineering, Design & Development, Quality and Production departments to facilitate New Product Introduction, engineering modification and supplier resourcing activities.

You will be responsible for Implementing the material and supplier procurement strategy for new projects, purchasing administration, maintaining accuracy of information and ensuring that parts are sourced cost-effectively and that sourcing decisions, commercial terms and supplier capabilities meet Melett requirements and conform to company procedures and goals.

Your responsibilities include

- 1. Participate as the representative from Supply Chain in project teams for the development phase of new products, ensuring all bought out components are purchased in line with set timing plans and budget.
- 2. Working with the Supply Chain, Engineering and Quality Assurance teams, select companies that meet technical, quality and commercial requirements, ensuring selection conforms to Melett purchasing strategy.
- 3. Negotiate contracts for new parts, aiming to achieve the best possible long term price, quality and service.
- 4. Place purchase orders in support of new product development (NPD) sample, pre-production in addition, start of production for new parts, liaising with freight forwarders to plan shipment collections and ensuring the smooth hand over of approved parts into serial production.
- 5. Ensure tight control is exercised over the cost and timely supply of purchased materials and samples during the project phase.
- 6. Monitoring supplier performance and support all internal departments in the resolution of supply issues ensuring the supplier responds according to the urgency of the situation.
- 7. PPAP Management.
